History:

Pupils will find out what seaside holidays and resorts were like in the past and comparing these to how they are today.

Pupils will look in detail at Victorian seaside activities and compare these to their modern day equivalent.

Pupils will explore and identify Victorian seaside artefacts such as clothes and games.

PSHE:

Pupils will be following the Jigsaw programme; Relationships. We will focus on relationships with our friends and family.

Term 5- HAWKS

Literacy:

Pupils will be beginning to understand what a diary is and identifying the features. Pupils will be writing their own diary entry as a Victorian school child going to the seaside.

Pupils will be beginning to understand what a play script is and identifying the features. Using the story Sharing a Shell, pupils will order the story and rewrite their own version, focussing on sentence structure.

PE:

Tuesday: Pupils will participate in weekly PE sessions led by a specialist sports coach.

Wednesday: Pupils will participate in weekly cycling sessions.

Geography:

Pupils will be identifying key physical and human features of the seaside such as, beach, cliff, sea, harbour and shop.

Pupils will be locating seashores on a map using aerial photographs to recognise key human and physical features.

Art:

Pupils will use shells to develop and improve a range of art and design techniques such as, colour and texture using pencil, charcoal, paint and collage.

Maths:

Calculation – understanding the concept of adding more by combining two groups of objects together, adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers. Multiplying numbers by 2, 5 and 10. Solving problems using multiplication, addition and subtraction.

Capacity and weight – comparing and ordering the capacity/weight of different containers/items and using the related vocabulary e.g. empty, full, half full, heavy, light. Measuring and recording the capacity/weight of a number of different containers/items.

Computing:

Pupils will take part in creating and debugging simple programmes using Scratch Junior software.

WOW Events:

Weston super Mare trip to experience a traditional British seaside visit first hand and visit the Victorian Museum to look at historical artefacts.

Train ride to Severn Beach to experience a Victorian journey to the seaside.

Homework:

Identifying the weight and capacity of different items in the supermarket.

Reading signs and labels in the environment.
