Maths

Number - Number recognition, number formation, counting, making groups of items, conservation of number, place value, ordering, and calculation- addition.
Shape, Space & Measure - Position & direction, length, patterns & sequences

Science

Movement- Push & pull, fast & slow, rolling, wheels/no wheels, moving from left to right. Moving vehicles down a variety slopes.
Investigating materials - Looking at which materials make the best wheels & are waterproof. Sorting & classifying materials & vehicles. Testina vehicles.

Literacy

Language and communication - Individual speech & language targets, functional & topic vocabulary, listening skills, bike role play, instructions, asking & answering questions.
Reading: Letter sounds & blending, word & sentence reading, decoding, comprehension questions, sequencing, retelling.
Writing: Mark making, spelling, handwriting, sentence, composition, name writing.
Topic Related- describing characters, settings and events, retelling, sequencing, labelling.

Design & Art

Investigating toy vehicles, attaching wheels, making our own wheeled vehicles using construction materials & junk modelling.
Painting with wheels, circles and cylinders, circular mark making & printing, observational drawing, bike wheel weaving
Cookery- making healthy choices, trying a variety of foods.

Music

Bicycle songs, playing percussion instruments along to story, vehicle sounds.

PSHE

Road & bike safety. Growing up, transitions and change. Staying healthy.

PE

Sensory integration programmes, dance & movement, travelling in different ways, making objects travel e.g. hoops, ribbons, balls following directions & commands.

ICT

Cause & effect apps & mark making using iPads & Smart Board. Recording sounds. Inserting text to label pictures.

General Homework Ideas...

Verbally label transport when out & in play.
Take a trip on a bicycle, bus, boat, train, or other forms of transport.
Share books: turning pages, following text left to right as you read out loud, looking at pictures together, pointing to them & commenting.
Count out items together around the home e.g. fruit into the fruit bowl.
