## Hawks Class – Term 6

### Under the Sea



#### Science:

In science pupils will be learning about animals and their habitats.

Pupils will sort mammals, amphibians, reptiles, birds and fish and identify their features.

Pupils will learn about different habitats, looking at the ocean in detail.

Pupils will identify, discuss and compare different animals and plants in the ocean.

#### Geography:

Pupils will identify and label the five oceans on a world map.

Pupils will also find, discuss and sort different water bodies such as rivers, lakes and ponds.

#### Art:

Using a range of media, such as paint, clay, papier-mâché, pastel and collage to create a 3D underwater habitat.

#### Homework:

Reading words and signs in the environment, discussing the size and weight of objects when shopping, exchanging money for items when shopping, exploring and identifying water sources.

#### PSHE:

Pupils will be following the Jigsaw programme for the topic 'Changing Me'.

During the topic pupils will be identifying their body parts and learn to respect and look after their bodies by healthy eating and personal hygiene.

Pupils will also discuss how we change and grow as we move from being a baby to a child to an adult and identify some of the things we can do at each age.

#### PE:

Tuesday: Pupils will participate in weekly PE sessions led by a specialist sports coach.

Wednesday: Pupils will participate in weekly cycling sessions.

#### English:

Using the stories 'Sharing a Shell' and 'Commotion in the ocean', pupils will develop their sentence structure. Pupils will be developing their letter formation and their use of punctuation such as capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as well as introducing the use of adjectives.

Pupils will develop their language comprehension by reading fiction and non-fiction texts about the ocean and answering questions about what they have read.

Pupils will experience reading, writing and listening to poems. Pupils will create their own acrostic and rhyming poems.

#### Maths:

Pupils will develop their knowledge and understanding of money by recognising and naming coins and notes, making different amounts and adding coins together.

Pupils will continue to develop their calculation skills by solving addition, subtraction and multiplication problems.

Pupils will record and compare the weight of different objects using balancing scales.
