Computing

Pupils will be exploring what computers are and how we use them.

Pupils will explore creating algorithms on Scratch Jr.

History

Pupils will explore Roman artefacts.

Pupils will learn about the Roman army, label the items worn and design a coat of armour.

Pupils will explore how the Romans built roads.

Geography

Pupils will locate England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales and Italy on a map, along with the 5 main oceans.

Pupils will identify and compare characteristics of England and Italy.

Pupils will explore landmarks of England and Italy.

Literacy

We will be focusing on traditional tales in particular:

Pupils will be sequencing and retelling the stories, looking at describing words and developing their independent sentence construction skills.
