Life skills: Writing and reading shopping lists

Functional skills: Maths

Money: Pupils will also be handling money at their level and using money in real life situations.

Accreditation: Pupils will complete relevant numeracy work that related to measure and space.

Cooking: Pupils will cook a simple meal, with a focus on measuring ingredients and using positional language.

Pupil work is individualised and relates to accreditation or EHCP targets.

ICT: Design and key skills

- Pupils will be using cameras on iPads to create a photo album of community visits to the farm. Pupils will then use clay and other materials to recreate a farm and the animals that live there.

Apollo class information

- **Each Tuesday morning** Apollo class will access **community visits**. We will visit St Werburghs Community farm. Pupils will be walking on clean paths and are unlikely to get muddy - however if you would prefer, pupils can wear/ send in wellies and old clothes.
- Our trip to the farm will be followed by a trip to Tesco at the Eastgate centre. This will be a great opportunity for pupils to practice using money in a café. We suggest that each pupil brings **£2 a week** to buy a drink or a snack.
- Apollo class have Forest school on 28th January. 11th February. We will also be walking around the woods around Kingsweston House every Friday afternoon. We suggest that pupils **bring a coat and waterproof shoes/ wellies on these days**.
- Pupils will attend a **weekly** activity group from **Thursday 24th January until the end of term**, they will need a packed lunch each Thursday.
