

Literacy: Recycling theme

Life skills: Writing and reading shopping lists

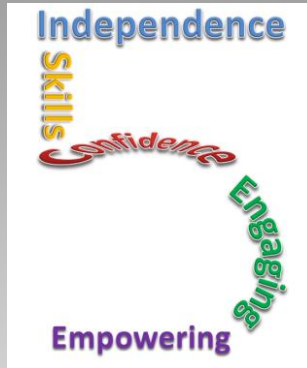
Each pupil will read and write at their level (photos, symbols or text)

Social skills: Asking and answering questions

Pupils will take part in structured speaking and listening games in ability groups.

Pupils will also work with others to play simple games.

Individual targets: Pupils will work 1:1 on EHCP targets and accreditation.

Theme: Looking after ourselves and the planet

Equals- Moving On Traveller

Independent living- shopping for and preparing lunch once a week

Science - Recycling and composting

Pupils will focus on recycling materials, plastic pollution, and decomposition.

Physical - individual targets. Pupils will also take part in a chosen activity at Briarwood school once a week (Yoga, dance or sport)

Functional skills: Maths Recycling theme

Money: Pupils will also be handling money at their level and using money in real life situations in the community.

Accreditation: Pupils will complete relevant numeracy work that related to using number.

Cooking: Pupils will cook a simple meal, counting and measuring ingredients.

Pupil work is individualised and relates to accreditation or EHCP targets.

Life Skills

- Pupils will work within roles in school during work experience week on 1st to 1th April.
- Pupils will cook their own dinner.
- Weekly community visits.
- Regular trips into the community using a public bus.
- Social skills: weekly trip to Briarwood

Apollo class information

- **Travel training:** Each Tuesday morning Apollo class will access community visits using public bus. Pupils will need their bus pass on Tuesday's.
- **Community visits:** On Tuesday's we will visit a café. We suggest that each pupil brings **£2 a week** to buy a drink or a snack.
- Pupils need packed lunches on Thursday and Tuesday
- **Life skills:**
- Pupils will cook their own healthy lunch on Wednesday. Pupils do not need a packed lunch on Wednesday as they will be making pasta salad, jacket potato or a sandwich (as appropriate).
- **Work experience:** Pupils will visit a community gardening project on Wednesday 27th March to take part in work experience. This will happen monthly until the end of term.
