

Moon Class - Term 4

Maths

Number: Number recognition, number formation, higher and lower, simple addition.

Shape, Space and Measure: We are learning the names of 2d and 3d shapes, and looking at shapes in the environment.

History

We are learning about historical inventions and learning about 'old and new' e.g. old toys and new toys, before inventing our own.

Literacy

Speaking: We are learning to use adjectives to describe objects and ideas linked to inventions.

Listening: We are developing our listening skills to answer who, what, where, when question types.

Writing: We are focussing on letter formation and writing our names. Some pupils are learning to keep their letters an appropriate size. We will use writing to 'label' inventions. Pupils have individual targets and will write their 'weekly news' every Monday.

Reading: Pupils working towards different phases from 'Letters and Sounds'

Design & Art

We using various materials to design and create 'inventions', allowing for imaginative play. Pupils will design their own inventions and present them to others.

Inventions



PE

This term in PE we are playing team games e.g. 'bench ball - pupils will begin to work on leadership skills and start creating their own rules and games.

Food Technology

Making cakes - linked to inventing dishes, being creative, decorating and personalising cakes. Focussing on measuring weight, mixing, food safety and hygiene.

PSHE

Throughout the year we will be playing team games and working on social skills, linked to EHCP targets.

In addition to this, we are learning about staying safe in the community - stranger danger, road safety.

Geography

We will learn about travel linked to inventions e.g. the car, plane, and will investigate how far each mode of transport could take us.
