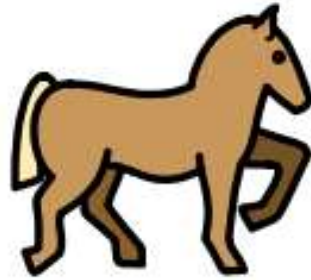


# Moon Class – Term 3 Curriculum

## Science + Humanities
