Maths

Otter class are currently working on the understanding of numbers up to 10 and problem solving of numbers up to 10. Counting using speech, sign language and iPad communicators are a good warm up and practice for then looking at patterns and puzzles with numbers up to 10.

English

In English lessons, Otter class are exploring IT resources to access and use confidently iPad Apps and PowerPoint presentation. The chosen Apps will support a trip to a café at the end of term and the PowerPoint presentations will provide information on the planned trip

Forest School

Students will be participating in different horticultural activities including; preparing sites for gardening and planting bulbs and seeds with Kelly.

Science

Otter class have started some exploratory science sessions this term. We are focussing on scientific enquiry skills through term 5 to prepare us for next term where states of matter will be studied.

PE

Ball control and passing the ball in pairs and groups is our focus this term. We are then developing these skills for football techniques. We are aiming to complete a ball dribbling obstacle course.
