Maths

Otter class are currently working on recognising money and using it to pay for food items. They will be practising this in the classroom and then will have the opportunity to apply the skills they have built in the community. Students will be paying for weekly snacks in a café and meals on two trips planned this term to the beach and a restaurant as part of our new reward chart.

English

In English lessons, Otter class are exploring different technologies. They will be identifying digital and non-digital items and then manipulate the digital items to find cause and effect. Digital images will be explored and the creating of these using different IT platforms will be discovered.

Forest School

Students will be participating in different horticultural activities including; preparing sites for gardening and planting bulbs and seeds with Katy.

Science

Otter class have started 'States of Matter' as their first topic after exploring different scientific skills last term. They are now applying these skills to identifying and testing Solids, Liquids and Gasses.

PE

Ball control and passing the ball in pairs and groups is our focus this term. We are then developing these skills for football techniques. We are aiming to complete a ball dribbling obstacle course.

Otter class are going to look at all the different people we have relationships with. We are going to recognise and identify these individuals and talk about healthy relationships and how we create and keep these. Different emotions will be explored and identified in ourselves and others as a tool to create these healthy relationships.
